Full-arch rehabilitation with dental implants in edentulous patients or those with compromised remaining teeth is a highly predictable treatment. Three-dimensional implant positioning and bone reduction (when indicated) are crucial for success. This training demonstrates the protocol for alveolar bone reduction, proper implant placement, selection of straight and/or angled abutments, and immediate provisional options.

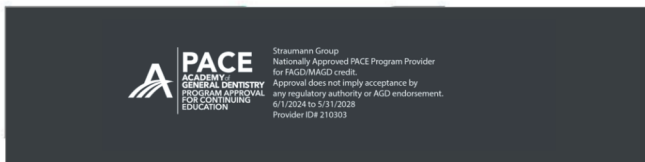
